A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting the city from charging non-profit organizations for garbage removal.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. Section 16-114 of title 16 of the administrative code of the city of New York, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§16-114. Collection and disposal; compensation for. --a. The Commissioner may charge for the collection and disposal of ashes, street sweepings, garbage, refuse, rubbish, dead animals, night soil and offal, and all wastes, including trade waste from business, industrial, manufacturing, or other establishments conducted for profit, at rates fixed by the board of estimate.

b. The city shall be prohibited from charging non-profit organizations for the collection and disposal of ashes, street sweeping, garbage, refuse, rubbish and other wastes or for the supplying of any special bags which the commissioner determines must be used for the disposal of garbage. The provisions of this subdivision shall not apply to the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
