What is CUNY Start?

CUNY Start is an intensive 18-week program that offers both part time and full time classes in academic reading, writing and math for students who have not passed one or more of the CUNY placement exams.

Why enroll in CUNY Start?

- Low cost: **\$75 per semester**, including books and materials
- Improve your reading, writing, and math skills
- 2 opportunities to retake CUNY placement exams
- Save financial aid and spend less time in remedial classes

To be eligible for CUNY Start, students must

- Apply to CUNY and be accepted to LAGCC
- Take the CUNY placement exams and must need to pass one or more exams
- RSVP and attend a CUNY Start info session
- Complete an application and be interviewed by a CUNY Start staff person
